## 29. REPORTS

### **29.1** County Councillor Report from Cllr McIntosh

Cllr McIntosh explained about the Healthy Streets Guide – if a development goes in, this system investigates the impacts on roads, sustainability, parking, schools, doctors and Your Fund Surrey etc Also "Create Streets" takes a more holistic view of what communities want their streets to look like. Further info will be coming from SCC regarding these initiatives

Chalk Pit Site – SCC will consider this application rather than District Council. There have been two consultations and majority in support of this new application. The application is putting forward a pavement for whole of Chalk Pit Lane with speed restrictions. They intend to site an Education Centre and get the Kilns listed.

Surrey County Council is looking at the application based on all the benefits and building 75 homes supported by the National Trust. This will then stop the HGVs running to and from the chalk pits. The alternative is that the operation continues until 2042 when their operator license runs out.

Your Fund Surrey – The hall at Crowhurst Lane End have requested £90,000 to convert and update the hall with a new roof and structural elements including heat pumps and a redesign. It is hoped that it will be agreed at panel as it will improve it and become a real community asset.

The "On Demand" transport service. It's a Uber Based Mini Bus Service which is available to the whole of Tandridge District. It also includes the Hospital and Redhill. The plan is to be county wide in the future. The system is based on an App but can also be phoned to book. The discount for young persons and the bus pass for pensioners can be used on this service too.

Highways are due to be working on the bottom end of Tandridge Lane on the 24<sup>th</sup> October for a week and a half – this is from the infant school to the Southlands Junction.

In the run up to the 2025 elections the boundaries of the wards will be changing. District Councillors will forward further information about this

The Local Plan has now been disbanded. The problems with junction 6 of the M25 was a major factor in the mitigation issues of taking it forward. Other issues were the land scam in the southern area where 300+ small patches were sold to individuals years ago
